# From the field...

**Afghanistan** GED Advisor recently visited the CO to jointly plan for a Training of Trainers (ToT) for staff. This is a follow-up to an earlier workshop with staff about what is GED and how we could promote it in our programming and in how we work within the organization. It is hoped that the TOT will enable a core group of CO staff to facilitate similar GED workshops for CARE Afghanistan and key partners.

*Sri Lanka:* The country office have been dialoging with the GED Advisors on an upcoming ToT on GED for Care Sri Lanka in Sep/Oct. The GED Team is also facilitating a dialogue between GED, and staff from Talent Management and Staff Well-being to consider a holistic approach to build the capacities of the staff for a stronger CARE Sri Lanka.

## CI Code of Conduct for Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse

The GED Team has been coordinating a process to develop a common policy (a Code Of Conduct) on the prevention of sexual exploitation and abuse (PSEA) for all of CARE International. This resulted from a February meeting on PSEA in Cairo. It is hoped that the common policy could be blessed by CI at the global conference in November.

### CI Harmonized Gender Policy
