# AN UPDATE FROM THE LIFE FREE FROM VIOLENCE **GLOBAL WORKING GROUP**



### The Life Free From Violence (LFFV) Outcome Area for CARE, has had a busy year!

The last 6 months were marked by efforts to strengthen collaboration with other Outcomes<sup>1</sup> and Approaches<sup>2</sup> and better coordinate CARE's global efforts around GBV. In April 2018, members of the LFFV Global Working Group met at the Annual CARE International Gender Network (CIGN) Meeting held in Paris, and brainstormed together on ways in which more resources can be mobilized for LFFV in the coming year. CIGN also provided the ideal forum to work through what CARE's approach to prevention of GBV in emergencies could look like. In May 2018, the LFFV Co-Leads were also part of the Programme Strategy Team held in Sri Lanka.

The LFFV Global Working Group is presently working through six smaller sub-teams representing six priority areas:

STRATEGY AND CONCEPT

**EVIDENCE AND LEARNING** 

**ADVOCACY AND INFLUENCE BUILDING** 

**RESOURCE MOBILIZATION** 

**REGIONAL STRATEGIES** 

**GBV IN EMERGENCIES** 

These smaller sub-teams have been set up and are now working towards identified goals until 2020. Here's a guick peek at what some of the sub-teams have been up-to over the past few months.



- A Theory of Change for CARE's GBV work has been developed and is available in English, Spanish, French and Arabic. Plans are currently underway to facilitate a series of sharing and learning conversations with regional teams on their current GBV programming and links to the LFFV Theory of Change.
- CI Gender Equality Policy has been updated to include specific commitment to increased budgetary allocation to fulfil CARE's gender commitment "specifically addressing measures for 'do no harm'/gender-based violence prevention measures, prevention of sexual exploitation and abuse (PSEA), and organizational gender equity and diversity (GED)."
